Hypoxemia in Ether Anesthesia. By Yajö Kulhus, Lieksa, Finland. Paper. Pp. 98 with illustrations. Mercatorin Kirjapaino, Helsinki, Finland, 1962.

Following a fairly extensive review of pertinent literature appearing before 1955 which dealt with oxygen deficiency and anesthesia, the author presents results of oximetric studies made in 1947-1948 at the Deaconess' Hospital, Helsinki, during anesthesia on 118 patients undergoing mainly major sungical procedures. Open mask ether was used in most cases with a few instances of the use of the Turcos machine, Ombrédanne mask, instillation mask, or local or intravenous methods. This study was conducted under grants from the Licensing Board and the Finnish Medical Association Duodecim. Berg's photocell oximeter was employed.

This monograph is replete with numerous tables

and oximetric tracings which add greatly to its value. The addition of concomitant explanatory notations to the tracings showing marked falls in blood oxygen saturation, would have enhanced understanding and educational worth of these tracings. That the majority of these anesthetics were administered by trainees undoubtedly explains the high incidence of complications. Unfortunately, in scattered sites in the text, some of the author's statistics are not in agreement with each other. There are occasional typographical and translation errors.

The author's investigative reports substantiate observations made by others that certain surgical and anesthetic procedures may cause serious hypoxemia. Every anesthesiologist and surgeon should be acutely aware of the potential hypoxic hazards presented in this publication.
