

waves observed during deep sodium thiopental anesthesia may support the hypothesis of synchronization of neuronal activity during anesthesia.<sup>20</sup> However, the mechanism by which the synchronization of the positive sharp cortical waves with MRF unit firings became unmasked during the deep stage of sodium thiopental anesthesia was not elucidated in the present study.

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### Drugs

**DEATH FROM ASPIRIN** A 23-year-old woman died following the ingestion of aspirin. Since large amounts of aspirin tablets in the gut seem to retard their own absorption, it is essential that serial salicylate determinations be obtained following the ingestion to make certain that continued increases in serum salicylate levels do not occur. Serum salicylate concentrations did not correlate with the state of consciousness or the magnitude of metabolic disturbance.
