BOOK REVIEW AND NOTICES

Manual of Medical Emergencies. By STUART C. CULLEN, M.D., AND E. G. GROSS, M.D. Ed. 2. The Year Book Publishers, Inc., 1953.

The purpose of this compact book is to provide an accessible and comprehensive account of measures to be taken by practitioners in dealing with medical emergencies. Basic principles associated with immediate restorative measures are stressed, and the value of a working diagnosis in enabling life saving procedures to be instituted is emphasized.

Of particular interest to anesthesiologists is the chapter on Airway and Artificial Respiration. It provides a lucid account of present day practice in treating airway obstruction and anoxia from various causes. Chapters dealing with circulatory collapse, unconscious state, acute poisoning and drug reactions encompass most of the emergencies met in the practice of medicine.

In the main, treatment as advised by the authors conforms to sound standard practice. This manual of 264 pages, including a useful catalogue of drugs, serves the dual purpose of an excellent brief review of current medical practice and a handy reference guide in emergency situations.
